TANA DONAGHY is a Senior Program Specialist with Los Angeles County Office of Education Division of Special Education. For more than a decade, she has worked with students, teachers, administrators and parents on providing quality content instruction for students with moderate to severe disabilities. She has begun to work with school districts on building collaborative models of service delivery between special education and general education teachers/programs.

She serves as the chair of special projects on the Special Education Administrators of County Offices (SEACO) board. She has also trained teachers and staff across the state of California and presents at conferences across the nation.

This discussion will focus on acquainting participants with the math instruction needs of students across the continuum of severity of disabilities who receive special education services.
